6. Events Offer For Competition :

6.1. Team Standing Events (Men and Women) :

Six Standing players per country / territory (Maximum) Minimum of four Standing players are allowed. Each player can play only once. Players participating in team event can also play in individual events.

6.2 Individual Events (Men and Women)

- 6.2.1 Singles and Doubles Wheelchair Class 1 (BMW 1)
- 6.2.2 Singles and Doubles Wheelchair Class 2 (BMW 2)
- 6.2.3 Singles and Doubles Wheelchair Class 3 (BMW 3)
- 6.2.4 Singles and Doubles Standing Below Waist Class 1 (BMSTL 1)
- 6.2.5 Singles and Doubles Standing Below Waist Class 2 /2a (BMSTL 2/2a)
- 6.2.6 Singles and Doubles Standing Below Waist Class 3/3a BMSTL 3/3a)
- 6.2.7 Singles and Doubles Standing Above Waist Class 1 (BMSTU 4)
- 6.2.8 Singles and Doubles Standing Above Waist Class 2 (BMSTU 5)
- 6.2.9 Mixed Doubles Wheelchair Combined Classes
- 6.2.10 Dwarfs – Singles and Doubles [BMSTD 6(1)/ 6 (2)]

7. Participation Qualification:

- 7.1. All members of APC or/and organizations which are affiliated to APC are allowed to participate.
- 7.2. Participating players must be citizens of the participating countries or territories.

8. Participation Quotas per country/ territory For Individual/Team Events:

- 8.1. **Individual Events - Singles** : Maximum of 4 players for each Event/Category per country / territory
- 8.2. **Individual Events - Doubles** : Maximum of 3 pairs for each Event / Category per country / territory
- 8.3. **Team Standing Events** : Maximum of 6 Standing players per team per country / territory . Standing Players are allowed to play in Team Standing and Individual Events and each team consists of two (2) singles and one
 - (1) Doubles of standing classes as follows:
 - Singles 1 (Standing Above Waist or of lower categories)
 - Singles 2 (Standing Below Waist)
 - Doubles (Standing Above Waist or of lower categories and Standing Below Waist)
 - Players are not allowed to play more than one match in the team event.
 - A minimum of 4 players are required for the team event.
 - A maximum of 2 reserve players are allowed per team.

- 9. **Tournament Committee:** The Organizer will set up an Organizing Committee comprising of persons with knowledge of badminton for person with disabilities to run the tournament. The committee includes a qualified referee and a qualified classifier.

10. Rules and Regulations :

- 10.1. The current rules of BWF and IBAD shall apply.
- 10.2. Feather shuttlecocks to be used during entire tournament with brand sanctioned by BWF speed of 77/78 .

11. Entry / Participation Fee:

- 11.1. Athlete : EUR 350
- 11.2. Staff : EUR 350
- 11.3. Participants arriving before 9 Dec 2008 or leaving after 15 Dec 2008 need to pay extra costs of EUR 70 per person per night
- 11.4. The entry fee of EURO 350 includes local transportation(airport – hotel-hotel-venue) accommodation (twin rooms) and meals from dinner on 9 Dec 2008 to breakfast on 15 Dec 2008. Single Room requires extra costs of EUR 30 per night.

12. Arrival / Departure And Other Advisory:

Participating countries are advised to arrive Bangalore on 9 Dec 2008 (Tuesday) and leave Bangalore on 15 Dec 2008 (Monday) Any arrival and departure before and after the dates stated are on own arrangements. All teams are also advised to insure members of the team throughout the competitions and arrange own visas and entry requirement.

13. Protest :

- 13.1 Appeals/ protest must be in writing with a deposit of EUR\$100.
- 13.2 Any matters relating to the player's qualification must be raised within 30 minutes after the player's classification is made /completed.
- 13.3 Appeals/ protest must be raised within 30 minutes after each game. Over the time limit of 30 minutes, appeals will not be accepted.
- 13.4 The deposit of appeals will only be returned if the appeals are approved on the decision by the Tournament Committee.

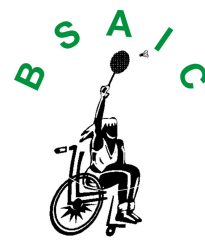
